Allows alcohol served at this event to be consumed by the public outdoors in public and semi public areas within the scope of the event.

5. Background:

The event will be a three day street festival to be held in the area of Old San Carlos Blvd., between First Street and Third Street. The area will be closed off to traffic for the duration of the event. There will not be a beer trailer at this event, but adjacent businesses will be open, serving food and alcohol. These businesses will also be obtaining alcohol extension of premises where needed. The special event will be held on Old San Carlos Blvd. between First Street and Third Street, and a section of Second Street closest to Old San Carlos Blvd. The event will run from 4:00 PM – 8:00 PM on Friday October 8, 2010, 8:00 AM – 8:00 PM Saturday October 9, 2010, and 8:00 AM – 6:00 PM Sunday October 10, 2010. This is a recurring annual special event for which the Town Council has previously approved open containers of alcohol in public areas, as provided in Ordinance 99-15, Chapter 62, Section 5(F). The ordinance does not appear to give staff the ability to approve such requests administratively. Please see the attached special event permit application and site plan submitted by SIK Promotions Inc.





The following restaurants will be applying for extension of licensed premises alcohol permits for the Fort Myers Beach Pirate Festival 2010, per my discussion with Suzanne King of SIK Promotions:

1. Yucatan Beach Stand - 250 Old San Carlos Blvd.
2. Nervous Nellie's Crazy Waterfront Eatery – 1131 First St.
3. Smokin' Oyster Brewery – 340 Old San Carlos Blvd.

Today, August 5th, I discussed with Lee County Sheriff Lt. Mike Ciolino the fact that the Yucatan Beach Stand and the Smokin' Oyster Brewery will have extension of licensed premises alcohol permits for the event, but both restaurants will not be adjacent to the event area where the streets will be closed and the open container ordinance will be waived. Lt. Ciolino stated that he discussed this issue with Steve DeAngelis of the Yucatan Beach Stand, and both restaurants understand that they only be allowed open containers of alcohol on their property within the limits of the extension of licensed premises alcohol permit.


Ye Olde Site Map

OLD SAN CARLOS BLVD




3RD STREET OPEN TO TRAFFIC


