Mayor and Council Members,

I just returned from a visit to the new county park now under construction across from the Seafarer's building. There was a small crew there with a front end loader engaged in breaking up and removing the paved area on the south side of the property. That pavement is now piled up and awaiting removal. The county's construction supervisor Skip Franklin was on site at the time and I spoke with him about the project. He indicated that they discovered an abandoned underground propane tank that must be removed and they are working to schedule that now. Site work will also require the "cleaning of the soil before additional work may proceed. The cleaning involves bringing in a piece of equipment that sifts through the soil and removes rocks and other debris. That equipment is coming in from Jacksonville and was originally scheduled to be done next week. Skip advised that the owner of that company has a change in his schedule that might allow him to be here this week and Skip is encouraging him to do so. Skip gave me his phone number so that he can answer any immediate questions we may have.
