

SUBJECT: Council Liaisons and Alternates to Advisory Boards and Committees

The following is provided to communicate the scope and purpose of the various Advisory Boards and Committees and their typical meeting times with the intent of appointing one (1) Council liaison and one (1) alternate to each.

Anchorage Advisory Committee

The Anchorage Advisory Committee (AAC) was established to advise staff and the Town Council on all issues pertaining to the Town's public mooring field. The AAC meets the third Wednesday of every month at 6:00 pm in Council Chambers at Town Hall. Currently Larry Kiker serves as the Council Liaison.

Bay Oaks Recreation Campus Advisory Board

The purpose of Bay Oaks Recreation Center Advisory Board (BORCAB) is to facilitate the accomplishment of the Bay Oaks Recreation Campus (BORC) mission (to provide individuals and groups passive and active recreational, social and community activities and events for both residents and visitors) and thereby to further the welfare of the citizens of the town and others utilizing the Bay Oaks Recreation Campus and its facilities, as well as to provide advice to the town council with regard to matters concerning the Bay Oaks Recreation Center and perform such other duties as the town council may assign to it. BORCAB typically meets on the first Thursday of each month at 9am in Council Chambers at Town Hall. Currently Jo List serves as the Council Liaison.

Community Resource Advisory Board

The Community Resources Advisory Board (CRAB) seeks to enhance the quality of life on Fort Myers Beach by creating a vision for the community. The advisory board intends to accomplish its mission through the promotion and implementation of such community activities as public education, leadership, volunteerism, beautification, and recreation through the development and cultivation of a corps of community leaders and volunteers. CRAB meets the first Thursday of each month at 3:00pm in the Council Chambers in Town Hall. Currently Bob Raymond serves as the Council Liaison.

Cultural and Environmental Learning Center Advisory Board

The Cultural and Environmental Learning Center Advisory Board (CELCAB) was formed in 1999 to oversee the Mound House. In 2006, the Town Council incorporated the development of Newton Park into the CELCAB mission. CELCAB typically meets the fourth Thursday of every month at 3:00 pm in Council Chambers at Town Hall. Currently Alan Mandel serves as the Council Liaison.

Marine Resources Task Force

The Marine Resources Task Force (MRTF) exists to promote stewardship of our marine resources. MRTF typically meets on the second Wednesday of every month at 6:00 pm at Town Hall. For the month of April, however, MRTF is scheduled to meet at 10:30 AM on Wednesday, April 13, 2011. Currently Tom Babcock serves as the Council Liaison.
