A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF FORT MYERS BEACH, FLORIDA REQUESTING MEMBERSHIP IN THE LEE COUNTY METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION, PROVIDING DISTRIBUTION AND EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Florida Statutes Chapter 339.175, (2) authorizes the Governor to determine the number of member of the Lee County Metropolitan Planning Organization; and,

WHEREAS, membership is especially important to newly established municipalities who must place greater emphasis on planning;

WHEREAS, the newly incorporated Town of Fort Myers Beach has a permanent population of 6,000 and explodes to 44,000 in the tourist season and is not a member.

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE TOWN OF FORT MYERS BEACH AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Request for Membership. The Town Council hereby requests that the Governor add to and reapportion the membership of the Lee County Metropolitan Planning Organization and to include a representative of the Town of Fort Myers Beach as a member.

SECTION 2. Distribution. The Mayor is authorized and directed to distribute a copy of this resolution to Governor Lawton Chiles, the Lee County Metropolitan Planning Organization and to such others as may be appropriate.

SECTION 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
