A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF FORT MYERS BEACH, FLORIDA  
ASSIGNING QUASI JUDICIAL DUTIES TO THE LOCAL PLANNING AGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Town of Fort Myers Beach Local Planning Agency "LPA" was established to further the welfare of the citizens of the town by helping to promote a better, more helpful, convenient, efficient, healthful, safe and attractive community environment and to insure that the unique and natural characteristics of the island are preserved; and,

WHEREAS, the powers and duties of the LPA include the duties which lawfully may be assigned to it by resolution of the town council, such as, but not limited to, the review, holding of public hearings and making recommendations to the town, on regulations, codes and other documents, as may be necessary to implement the official comprehensive land use plan such as a zoning code, zoning map, subdivision regulations and codes for building construction and equipment,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE FORT MYERS BEACH TOWN COUNCIL, that the Council authorizes and directs the Local Planning Agency to review and forward recommendations on all petitions to the Council identified by the Town Manager as regarding land use matters.
