

RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF

RESOLUTION NUMBER 96- 19

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF FORT MYERS BEACH, FLORIDA REQUESTING THE COUNTY RELEASE CONTINENTAL CABLEVISION, INC., FROM IT'S FRANCHISE FOR THE SERVICE AREA INCLUDED WITHIN THE TOWN.

WHEREAS, Florida Law 95-494, established the Town of Fort Myers Beach effective December 31, 1996; and,

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the citizens of the Town of Fort Myers Beach that the Town control certain services to the citizens through direct franchise with the provider; and

WHEREAS, Lee County has a franchise with Continental Cablevision, Inc. that includes the area within the Town of Fort Myers Beach; and,

WHEREAS, Lee County franchise with Continental is controlled by Ordinance No. 89-05, which by it's expressed terms applies only to the unincorporated areas of Lee County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE FORT MYERS BEACH TOWN COUNCIL, that Lee County is requested to release Continental Cablevision, Inc., from it's franchise for the service area included within the Town of Fort Myers Beach.

FURTHER, the Council authorizes and directs the Town Manager to commence negotiations with Continental Cablevision, Inc. for a direct franchise for cable service for the citizens of the Town and to distribute this resolution as necessary to implement it's intent.

The foregoing resolution was adopted by the Fort Myers Beach Town Council upon being put to a vote, the result was as follows:
