RESOLUTION NUMBER 96- 29

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF FORT MYERS BEACH, FLORIDA, IN SUPPORT OF APPROVAL OF THE PROPOSED LEE COUNTY 0.5 MILL CONSERVATION LAND ACQUISITION TAX FOR A SEVEN YEAR PERIOD, PROVIDING TOWN APPROVAL, URGING TO VOTE "FOR" AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, a referendum in the November, 1996 general election is being held to adopt and approve the levy of 0.5 mills of county ad valorem taxes for a 7 year period to finance the proposed Lee County Conservation 2020 Land Acquisition Program; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Fort Myers Beach strongly supports such an effort to preserve and protect the environmentally critical and sensitive lands of Lee County,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF FORT MYERS BEACH, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Town Approval. The Town Council of the Town of Fort Myers Beach hereby expresses its approval the proposed "Lee County Conservation 2020 Public Lands Acquisition Program".

Section 2. Urging to vote "FOR". The Council also urges its residents to vote "FOR" an ad valorem tax of 0.5 mills county wide for a 7 year period

Section 3 Effective Date. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the Fort Myers Beach Town Council

The foregoing resolution was adopted by the Fort Myers Beach Town Council upon being put to a vote, the result was as follows:




