

RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF
THE TOWN OF FORT MYERS BEACH, FLORIDA
RESOLUTION NUMBER 97- 27

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF FORT MYERS BEACH, FLORIDA, DECLARING THE SHERIFF AS HAVING THE FULL POWER AND AUTHORITY OF A POLICE DEPARTMENT OF THE TOWN AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town of Fort Myers Beach, incorporated under Chapter 95-494, Laws of Florida, is desirous of having the Sheriff of Lee County, Florida, furnish enhanced law enforcement services to its citizens and visitors as permitted by Florida Statute 125.0101; and,

WHEREAS, the Town requests and the Sheriff agrees to continue to provide law enforcement services at a level similar to that provided during recent years, and prior to incorporation, it being understood and agreed that the Sheriff cannot guarantee a specific level of service in the absence of sufficient consideration to cover the costs of deputies who would be assigned exclusively to the Town; and

WHEREAS, Florida Statute 125.0101 requires that " such services shall be funded as agreed upon between the county and the municipality," and the Board of County Commissioners of Lee County, Florida, has approved the Town directly contracting with the Sheriff.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF FORT MYERS BEACH, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Town Declaration. The Town Council of the Town of Fort Myers Beach hereby declares that the Sheriff shall perform the duties and functions and shall have the full power and authority of a police department of the Town.

Section 2. Effective Date. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the Fort Myers Beach Town Council.


The foregoing resolution was adopted by the Fort Myers Beach Town Council upon being put to a vote, the result was as follows:


