WHEREAS, the fresh water impacts that affect the water quality in Estero Bay and the Gulf of Mexico are of deep concern to the Town due to the direct economic impact to property values, tourism, estuarine dependent businesses and others; and

WHEREAS, a recent review of the Primary Water Budget Components: 1995 Base, 2050 Base and Alternative D13R has given the town of Fort Myers Beach cause for concern.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF FORT MYERS BEACH THAT:



The foregoing Resolution was adopted by the Town Council upon a motion and second and, upon being put to a vote, the result was as follows:




