

RESOLUTION NUMBER 99- 35

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF FORT MYERS BEACH, FLORIDA, TO ESTABLISH GUIDELINES FOR EXPENDITURES FOR ROAD AND DRAINAGE MAINTENANCE; GUIDELINES WHERE THE TOWN HAS NO ROAD AND/OR DRAINAGE MAINTENANCE EASEMENT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town of Fort Myers Beach, has road and drainage maintenance responsibilities and must set guidelines for meeting that purpose.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF FORT MYERS BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION ONE: Guidelines For Expenditures For Road And Drainage Maintenance. No public funds shall be expended for road and/or drainage maintenance unless the Town has a valid easement to maintain the improvement.

SECTION TWO: Guidelines where the Town has no road and/or drainage maintenance easement:

- a. Property owners where the Town has no road and/or drainage maintenance easement may request assistance by filing a request with the Town Manager.
- b. Upon receipt of the request, the Town Manager will identify the improvements required and the necessary easements.
- c. Property owners will be responsible for the cost of title insurance and preparation of deeds granting the easement.

SECTION THREE: Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective upon adoption.


The foregoing resolution was adopted by the Fort Myers Beach Town Council upon being put to a vote, the result was as follows:


