

RESOLUTION NUMBER 00-10

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF FORT MYERS BEACH, FLORIDA, PROVIDING FOR A REQUEST TO FAA FLIGHT CONTROLLERS AND DIRECTION TO THE TOWN MANAGER.

WHEREAS, the JEPS Manual provides that airlines approaching the Southwest Florida International Airport should voluntarily maintain height to 3000 feet until reaching the coastline; and,

WHEREAS, each year more planes are using the Southwest Florida International Airport, causing increased traffic over the Town of Fort Myers Beach adversely impacting the quality of life of the residents; and,

WHEREAS, our neighbors in Miami Beach have the same situation as we have in that they live about 10 miles from the local international airport; and,

WHEREAS, the FAA flight controllers at Miami International inform/remind in their dialog with the pilots to "maintain 3000 feet" until passing over the coastline.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF FORT MYERS BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION ONE: Request to FAA Flight Controllers. That the FAA flight controllers at Southwest Florida International Airport in consideration and support for a more consistent approach elevation, institute the same procedures as at the Miami International Airport and inform/remind in their dialog with the pilots to "maintain 3000 feet" until passing over the coastline.


SECTION TWO: Direction To The Town Manager. The Town Manager is directed to distribute this resolution as necessary so as to implement the requested action.

The foregoing resolution was adopted by the Fort Myers Beach Town Council upon being put to a vote, the result was as follows:




