

RESOLUTION NUMBER 01-10

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE EXISTING FEES FOR
WATER UTILITY SERVICE WITHIN THE TOWN OF FORT
MYERS BEACH

WHEREAS, Ordinance 01-03 provides in Section 8. Rates and Charges. That the fees and charges (which also include connection/disconnection charges, impact fees, readiness-to-serve charges, demand charges, meter charges, and the like) in effect on the effective date of the ordinance shall be the same after purchase by THE TOWN OF FORT MYERS BEACH PUBLIC WORKS SERVICES, INC..

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF FORT MYERS BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. The fees and charges for water utility service shall remain as:

Exception: If a general service connection serves living units such as hotel, motel, or timeshare,

etc., with efficiency units that include a kitchen or kitchenette and/or laundry facilities, the connection charge shall be the higher of the fee from the meter size schedule above or the number of dwelling units based on the multi-family ERU equivalent.

The following schedule of miscellaneous service charges set forth below shall be applicable to all customers:

Charges for larger meter taps shall be based on estimates of actual time and expense. Amounts collected in excess of actual costs shall be credited to the customer's account or refunded, as applicable. Amounts due, caused by underestimation, shall be billed and payable within (10) days.

C. TAP-IN CHARGES:

In addition to new installations, there rate may also apply to water service upgrades or facility relocations.

Charges for larger meter taps shall be based on estimates of actual time and expense. Amounts collected in excess of actual costs shall be credited to the customer's account or refunded, as applicable. Amounts due, caused by underestimation, shall be billed and payable within (10) days.

D. PREMISE VISIT (Trip Charge) - \$20.00

Includes charges for meter re-reads and special reads, customer requested meter test, and any specific activities where a trip to the customer's premises is requested by the customer or as required by the company. Upon written request of any customer, the company shall, without charge, make a field test for accuracy of the water meter in use at customer's premises, provided the meter has not been tested within the past twelve months.

The above deposit amounts are minimums. Additional deposit amounts may be required in order to secure payment of current bills.



The foregoing resolution was adopted by the Fort Myers Beach Town Council upon being put to a vote, the result was as follows:




