RESOLUTION NUMBER 01- 32

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF FORT MYERS BEACH, FLORIDA EXPRESSING SUPPORT FOR THE PROPOSED ASSESSMENT, COLLECTION AND APPLICATION OF SCHOLL DISTRICT IMPACT FEES; CALLING UPON THE LEE COUNTY COMMISSION TO ENSURE THAT ANY FUNDING PROVIDED BY WAY OF SCHOOL IMPACT FEES BE PROPORTIONATELY SHARED WITH THE TOWN OF FORT MYERS BEACH; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Lee County board of County commissioners is considering the assessment, collection and application of public school district impact fees within the County; and

WHEREAS, there has been no impact fee funding for public schools in Lee County; and

WHEREAS, the cost of new public infrastructure, including public schools, should be borne primarily by those creating the demand for it, rather than the public at large; and

WHEREAS, it is fair and proper for any expenditure of public funds, including impact fees for public schools, to be proportionately shared throughout Lee County;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF FORT MYERS BEACH, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The Town Council of the Town of Fort Myers Beach hereby expresses its support to the proposed impact fees for public school funding.

Section 2. The Town Council hereby calls upon the Lee County Board of County Commissioners to adopt and support impact fee assessment, collection and application of impact fee funds for public schools and to ensure that Town of Fort Myers Beach public schools proportionately share in such funds.

Section 3. Effective Date. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the Fort Myers Beach Town Council.


The foregoing resolution was adopted by the Fort Myers Beach Town Council upon being put to a vote, the result was as follows:




