**Tips for a More Comfortable Visit**

- Do the "Stringray Shuffle" while you are in the water by sliding your feet along the ocean floor to avoid stepping on a stingray and getting stung.
- Small insects called "No-see-ums" can cause painful bites. Repellent is available at many local shops.
- Don't stay in the sun too long! Floridians often refer to the native gumbo limbo tree as the "toughest tree" because, like some of our sun-worshipping visitors who stay too long at the beach, its bark is red and peely.

**Public Parks**

Bowditch Point Park - Open 7am to dusk, seven days a week. \$2 per hour parking (Restrooms, Picnic Area, Nature Trail, Shower Station, Boardwalk).

Pier and Lynn Hall Memorial Park - Open 7am - 11pm, seven days a week. \$2 per hour parking (Restrooms, Gills, Picnic Area, Shower Station, Licensed Fishing Pier, Food/Concessions, Beach Access).

Lover's Key State Park - Open 8am - dusk, seven days a week. \$8 per day parking (Restrooms, Picnic Area, Nature Trail, Shower Station, Bicycling, Paddling, Licensed Fishing from Beach, Food/Concessions, Boat Ramp).

**Public Beach Access Points**

Estero Island is home to seven miles of coastline and more than 30 beach access points marked with colorful beach access signs. Many are near restaurants and cafes. Parking is \$2 /hour • [www.fortmyersbeachfl.gov](http://www.fortmyersbeachfl.gov).

• All live shells including sand dollars, sea urchins and hermit crabs are prohibited from collection. Violators are subject to fine and jail time. Little Estero Island critical Wildlife Area provides nesting habitat for federally listed, threatened species. Please help protect wildlife by adhering to any posted regulations.

• Please do not walk on dunes or pick sea oats. These are federal offenses and are subject to stiff fines.

• Speed limits and parking areas are strictly enforced. No parking on any side street at any time. For more information, contact Beach and Street Enforcement at 239.765.0202, or visit [www.fortmyersbeachfl.gov](http://www.fortmyersbeachfl.gov).

• A fishing license is required - except at the pier - may be obtained at local bait shops, manans, the Lee County Tax Collector's office or at [www.myfwc.com](http://www.myfwc.com). For fishing regulations: [www.fortmyersbeachfl.gov](http://www.fortmyersbeachfl.gov).

**Fort Myers Beach Rules and Regulations**

Use recaptured provided to deposit trash. Remember balloons, plastic and other litter are deadly to wildlife.

Use designated crosswalks when crossing Estero Blvd. Do not assume oncoming traffic will stop.

In the presence of thunder or lightning, seek immediate shelter.

Vehicles, camping, fireworks and the possession and consumption of alcoholic beverages is prohibited on beaches. Florida's drinking age is 21 and is strictly enforced.

Dogs are allowed on the beaches, but must be properly leashed, cleaned up after, and restrained at all times by a hand-held leash no more than 6' long. Violators of this ordinance are subject to fines. A leash-free dog beach is located south of Lover's Key State Park.

SWFL is one of the few localities where endangered giant frog-headed turtles lay eggs. Do not disturb the turtles in their nests. Baby hatchlings are drawn to light looking for the moon, making preservation efforts a matter of life and death. No lights may be visible from anywhere on the beaches at night during turtle season (May through October). For more information, visit [www.turtletime.org](http://www.turtletime.org).

**Option 1: Private Lots**

There are numerous privately owned lots for FMB parking. A majority are on the north end of the island along Old San Carlos Blvd. and Crescent St., as well as the first stretch of Estero Blvd. heading south. These lots charge a daily rate between \$5 to \$25 per day. Parking may be more during special events.

**Option 2: Town-Owned Lots: Short and Long-Term**

Short-term parking, or metered parking, is located on Old San Carlos and Estero Blvd., Center St., and Fifth St. These metered spaces have a two-hour time limit and cost \$3/hr. Long-term parking is available on all beach access streets and in the lot under the Matanzas Pass Bridge. Cost is \$3/hr, and there is no time limit.

**Beach-Access Parking**

Public beach access is plentiful, with a number of designated public beach access points and streets, along with a number of city and county parks. All public beach access streets have a sign where the street meets Estero Blvd. Metered parking is available on many of the beach access streets at \$2 per hour; however, the ones closer to town do not have parking.

**Handicapped Policy for Town Lots**

If you possess a valid handicapped parking placard or license, you may park in any town-owned metered spaces as long as a handicapped space is unavailable. Parking in these instances is free, time limit of four hours enforced.

**Payments for Town Lots**

Make sure you are legally parked. Then read the instructions on the pay station or meter. Should you have any questions, you may contact B.A.S.E. at (239) 463-5888 during business hours 9am - 9pm, seven days a week. This number is also provided on each pay station and parking meter.

The town of Fort Myers Beach has recently implemented 10 new pay stations at the following locations: Newton Park, Connecticut Street Beach Access, Palm Avenue Beach Access, Old San Carlos and under Matanzas Pass Bridge. These new pay-by-space pay stations allow visitors to park, take note of what parking space they are in, pay at the pay station and go directly to the beach without returning to display their ticket in their car.

Take advantage of the Town's Passport Parking App to pay for your Fort Myers Beach parking. The app is free to download on the App Store or Google Play or access at <https://pprk.com/park>. The app allows drivers to: Monitor their parking sessions - View payment history - Extend time remotely - Receive email receipts

**Avoid A Ticket!**

Meters are monitored 9am - 9pm, seven days a week, including all holidays. Town personnel look for expired time limits, overtime parking, and parking violations (i.e. parking in the wrong direction).

**Option 3: County Owned Lots**

Fort Myers Beach parking is available at Lynn Hall Park or Crescent Beach Park on either side of Times Square or at Bowditch Point on the north tip of the island. Cost is \$2 per hour with no time limit. The hours of each park are:  
Lynn Hall - 7am - 11pm daily  
Crescent Beach - 7am to dusk daily  
Bowditch Point - 7am to dusk daily

**Lee County Annual Parking Passes**

You can purchase an annual parking pass from Lee County for \$60. It can be used in many Lee County Parks locations. However, on Fort Myers Beach it can only be utilized at Bowditch Point Park.

**Handicapped Policy for County Lots**

Vehicles displaying a disabled Veterans license plate or vehicles with mechanical modifications specifically for accommodation for a disabled driver or passenger when parked in a space designated for the disabled are not subject to parking ticket.

You can pay your parking ticket online at [www.fortmyersbeachfl.gov](http://www.fortmyersbeachfl.gov), over the phone. In person at Town Hall (2525 Estero Blvd.), or send a payment via mail. To avoid a convenience fee, call (239) 463-5888 to pay over the phone. Business hours are Monday through Friday, 8:30am - 4:30pm.
