Watch Town Council meetings live

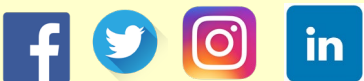

Masks are also encouraged.

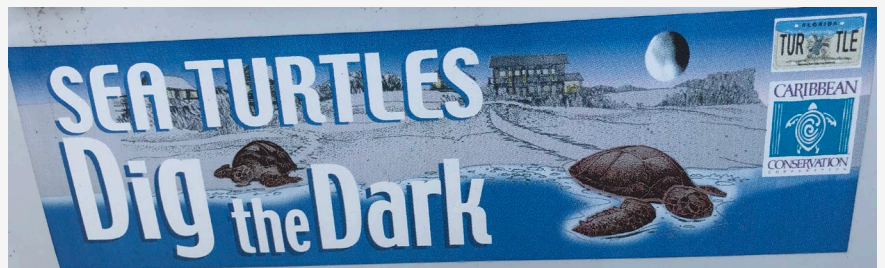
PLEASE NOTE: All Town Hall employees and visitors may not have been vaccinated.
