


Parks and Recreation

Mound House Historic and Archaeological Site

Acquired with funds from Florida Communities Trust in 2000, the Mound House has moved forward on providing high quality educational programs to the public while meeting site development needs. Recently completed projects include the construction of a kayak landing that connects visitors to the Great Calusa Blueway Kayak Trail in Estero Bay and the initiation of the walk-in shell mound exhibit, “Stories Beneath our Feet”, where visitors have the opportunity to walk inside a 2,000 year old Calusa Indian mound.



The site is home to the oldest still standing structure on Estero Island, dating back to 1906. The William H. Case addition is currently being restored to its 1921 grandeur and Mound House grounds are blooming with over 100 different species of native and historically accurate vegetation. To add to the historical ambience and provide further opportunities to meet the facility's educational mission, Mound House offers a Plants and People Tour; a tour of the “Stories Beneath our Feet Exhibit”; scheduled guided Kayak excursions to surrounding Indian Mound sites, as well as youth and adult educational programs.

Newton Park

Newton Park is a public beach front property and historic home rich in island history associated with Jim and Ellie Newton whose extensive friendships with Thomas Edison, Henry Ford, Harvey Firestone, Charles Lindbergh, and others are recorded in Jim Newton's book, "Uncommon Friends". The park features a covered Chickee Hut for outdoor picnicking, Bocce Ball Courts, public restrooms and beach access parking. The park and home are both available for rentals.

By virtue of the Newton's personal associations and the gatherings that took place at Seven Seas, the Town of Fort Myers Beach successfully obtained \$2.3 million in grant funds from the state of Florida's Florida Communities Trust program and Lee County to acquire the estate in 2003. Additional funds from the Lee County Tourist Development Council and Town park impact fees have been made available to develop the property into a passive park and community gathering place for all to enjoy.

Estero Island's Historic Structures

Estero Island has many historic sites and hidden gems. Help us continue to preserve these sites by encouraging public and private owners to take care of them. A handful of the sites are below, a more comprehensive list may be found at www.fortmyersbeachfl.gov.

161 Bay Road

Located at the entrance to the 57 acre Matanzas Pass Preserve, at the end of Bay Road behind the Fort Myers Beach Elementary School.

251 Pearl Street

Built in 1937, it was originally a one room cottage of hardwood pine with rough cut beams.



5601 Williams Drive

The Episcopal Church is the oldest church building on the island and was completed in 1953. It was built as a mission style structure with handmade cinder blocks of beach sand, coquina and limestone.

Estero Island's Historic Structures



2751 Oak Street

Originally built with 6 classrooms and an auditorium, it has expanded with a primary wing, media and computer center and 2 playgrounds. Today it serves grades K – 5.

289 Connecticut Street

The Case family's earliest house on the site was placed atop this Calusa Indian mound in 1906. The property was purchased in 2000 by the Town of Fort Myers Beach to serve as a cultural and environmental center on Estero Bay




