Bay Oaks Recreational Campus encompasses 15 acres and is operated by the Town. The campus features a community pool, two baseball/softball fields, a disc golf course, three outdoor pickleball courts, four tennis courts, a basketball court, a playground, and a gym with a fitness center.

Also provided are summer youth programs, after-school programs, and adult and senior programs and classes. The campus has a variety of open natural space for the community and visitors to enjoy. Plans are underway to significantly redevelop Bay Oaks with construction expected to start this year and be completed in 2023.
