Join the Town’s beautification project the week of September 18
Free trash bags at Town Hall for residents, property owners to participate

Town of Fort Myers Beach, FL – During the week of Sept. 18, 2023, the Town will be conducting a five day “Island Beautification” project to clear pesky small piles of construction debris and yard waste that are littering sidewalks and curbsides.

Property owners and residents are asked to participate by using compostable trash bags supplied by the Town to collect yard waste and small construction debris near their properties. (Please, no chemical waste such as paint, pool or automotive liquids, etc.) Place the bags curbside according to the following streets and pickup days:

5	Driftwood Lane to Estrellita Drive	Friday, 9-22-23

Set bags out the night before this special pickup day. Each household will receive five bags. This special pickup is in addition to the usual regular pickup day.

The Town of Fort Myers Beach is on Estero Island off the southwest Florida coast of the Gulf of Mexico. The beach stretches for seven miles and is known for white sand, shell finds, and sunsets. The Town took a direct hit in September 2022 from Hurricane Ian, a category five storm, and is in active recovery. Many shops and restaurants are restored and open for business! The Town has been incorporated since 1995.

To pick up trash bags, come to the BASE Office at the Town Hall Complex between 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday, at 2545 Estero Boulevard. Bags will also be available from the BASE office on Saturday, Sept. 16, and Sunday, Sept. 17, from 11 a.m. to 4 p.m. Look for signs that direct to the correct modular trailer on the Town Hall Complex.
