Town to hold community recovery workshops September 18 and 19

Town of Fort Myers Beach, FL – The Town will host two community recovery workshops to share information about the Town’s current and near-term projects to rebuild after Hurricane Ian.

The workshops will be held on Monday, Sept. 18, from 6 to 7:30 p.m. and Tuesday, Sept. 19, from 10 to 11:30 a.m. The workshops will be the same on both days. Participants can plan to attend the one that is most convenient for them. Both workshops will be held at DiamondHead Resort, 2000 Estero Boulevard, Fort Myers Beach.

At the workshops, Town staff will be providing updates on current and near-term recovery projects, and representatives from FEMA will be providing information about long-term recovery projects. The agenda includes time for those who attend to provide input.

The Town of Fort Myers Beach is on Estero Island off the southwest Florida coast of the Gulf of Mexico. The beach stretches for seven miles and is known for white sand, shell finds, and sunsets. The Town took a direct hit in September 2022 from Hurricane Ian, a category five storm, and is in active recovery. Many shops and restaurants are restored and open for business! The Town has been incorporated since 1995.
