

UPDATE regarding the Florida Department of Transportation Matanzas Pass Bridge

Town of Fort Myers Beach, FL – On May 28, 2024, the Town of Fort Myers Beach was notified of a beehive on the Matanzas Pass Bridge. We immediately contacted the Florida Department of Transportation in regard to the issue and urged walkers and bicyclists to use caution.

On May 29, 2024, at 7:30PM, Councill Farms safely removed the beehive and bees from the bridge. This area is no longer blocked off.

The Town of Fort Myers Beach is on Estero Island off the southwest Florida coast of the Gulf of Mexico. The beach stretches for seven miles and is known for white sand, shell finds, and sunsets.
