Town of Fort Myers Beach Officials and Staff meet with Florida Department of Transportation

Town of Fort Myers Beach, FL – Yesterday, January 7, 2025, Mayor Dan Allers, Town Manager Andrew Hyatt, Community Services Director Jeff Hauge, and Operations and Compliance Director Frankie Kropacek met with representatives from Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) to discuss the Estero Boulevard project. Topics discussed were as follows:

- Lighting on Matanzas Pass Bridge
- Maintenance of Traffic (MOT) Plan
- Concrete islands and landscaping
- Traffic signals on San Carlos Island
- Traffic Control (flaggers) in the construction area

The Town did not receive any definitive answers during the meeting but is committed to finding solutions. We will continue to follow up with FDOT regarding these concerns.

The Town of Fort Myers Beach is on Estero Island off the southwest Florida coast of the Gulf of Mexico. The beach stretches for seven miles and is known for white sand, shell finds, and sunsets. The Town took a direct hit in September 2022 from Hurricane Ian, a category five storm, and is in active recovery. Many shops and restaurants are restored and open for business!
