A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF FORT MYERS BEACH,  
FLORIDA, ESTABLISHING REASONABLE FEE FOR THE USE OF TIMES  
SQUARE MALL AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town of Fort Myers Beach has adopted an ordinance known as the  
Town of Fort Myers Beach Parks and Recreation Ordinance; and,

WHEREAS, that ordinance provides in part that the Town Council may by Resolution  
establish reasonable fees for the use of any park facility or authorize the procurement of park  
concessionaires; and,

WHEREAS, it is to the best interest of the Town to assign spaces to restaurants abutting  
the Times Square Mall.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF  
FORT MYERS BEACH, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Reasonable fee. The Town Council of the Town of Fort Myers Beach hereby sets  
\$400.00 per table per year as a reasonable fee for a permit for the extension of business into the  
Times Square Mall.

Section 2. Effective Date. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the  
Fort Myers Beach Town Council


The foregoing resolution was adopted by the Fort Myers Beach Town Council upon being  
put to a vote, the result was as follows:




