

RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF
THE TOWN OF FORT MYERS BEACH, FLORIDA
RESOLUTION NUMBER 98- 28

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF FORT MYERS BEACH, FLORIDA, CALLING FOR ELECTION; APPLICABLE LAW; POLLING PLACES; NOTICE; CANDIDATES FOR SEAT TWO; CANVASSING; DECLARATION AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town of Fort Myers Beach Charter provides: Section 5.07 Multiple candidates.--In the event that multiple candidates qualify for election to a single office, that candidate receiving a majority of votes cast shall be elected. If no candidate receives a majority, then the two candidates receiving the most votes shall have a runoff election to decide the winner of the election for that office. If required, the runoff election shall be held on the first Tuesday in December; and,

WHEREAS, the Town Charter requires periodic elections for membership on the council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF FORT MYERS BEACH, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Calling for Election. There is hereby called an election in the Town of Fort Myers Beach, to be held the 1st day of December, 1998, for the purpose of having all of the qualified electors within the Town to determine the member of the council for seat #2.

Section 2. Applicable Law. Said election shall be conducted according to the requirements of law governing municipalities.

Section 3. Polling Places. The election shall be held at the precinct polling places heretofore designated by the Supervisor of Elections in Lee County, Florida. The polls shall be opened and closed as provided by law and the ballot shall contain the names of the candidates to be voted upon in said election.

Section 4. Notice. The publication of notice of election shall be in a newspaper of general circulation within the Town at least twice once in the week prior to the week in which the election is to be held.

Section 5. Candidates For Seat Two. The names of the candidates who have qualified for Council member Seat #2, shall appear on the election ballot as follows:

COUNCIL MEMBER SEAT TWO

LENA HEYMAN
DANIEL HUGHES

Section 6. Canvassing. The appropriate election officials shall canvass the ballots and certify same to the Lee County Supervisor of Elections and the Supervisor shall in turn, certify the election results to the Town of Fort Myers Beach Council.

Section 7. Declaration. The Town Council shall declare the results thereof and such returns shall be recorded in the minutes of the Town Council at the first meeting after certification.

Section 8. Effective Date. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the Fort Myers Beach Town Council.

The foregoing resolution was adopted by the Fort Myers Beach Town Council upon being put to a vote, the result was as follows:


