RESOLUTION NUMBER 98- 31

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF FORT MYERS BEACH,
FLORIDA, SETTING A HEARING TO CONSIDER RESTRICTING
THE TRAFFIC ON A PORTION OF SHELL MOUND ROAD
BETWEEN VOORHIS AVENUE AND CONNECTICUT STREET TO
ONE WAY SOUTH TRAFFIC, PROVIDING PUBLIC HEARING;
DESCRIPTION OF REGULATED ROAD; PROPOSED
RESTRICTIONS AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town of Fort Myers Beach has the governmental, corporate, and proprietary "Home Rule Powers" pursuant to Article VIII, Section 2 of the Constitution of the State of Florida and Chapter 166 of the Florida Statutes to enable it to conduct municipal government, perform municipal functions, and render municipal services, and may exercise any power for municipal purposes, except when expressly prohibited by law; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that the Town Council consider restriction of motor vehicle traffic on that portion of a public road.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF FORT MYERS BEACH, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Public Hearing. The Town Council of the Town of Fort Myers Beach hereby sets 6:30 P.M. on December 21, 1998, as the time and date of a public hearing to consider restrictions on motor vehicle traffic on a portion of Shell Mound Road between Voorhis Avenue and Connecticut Street to one way south traffic.

Section 2. Description of Regulated Road. That portion of Shell Mound Road between Voorhis Avenue and Connecticut Street.

Section 3. Proposed Restrictions. From January 15 to April 15 of each year, motor vehicle traffic shall be restricted to south bound only.

Section 4. Publication. The Town Manager shall cause this resolution to be published one time at least one week before the public hearing and for a copy of this resolution to be delivered to all property owners abutting the restricted road.

Section 5. Effective Date. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the Fort Myers Beach Town Council

The foregoing resolution was adopted by the Fort Myers Beach Town Council upon being put to a vote, the result was as follows:
