A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF FORT MYERS BEACH, FLORIDA
SUPPORTING THE 1999 LEGISLATIVE ACTION AGENDA OF THE FLORIDA LEAGUE
OF CITIES.

WHEREAS, the Florida League of Cities has developed a Legislative Action Agenda for 1999 that is designed to assist municipalities on a number of far-ranging topics, including: Municipal Revenue Sharing Reform, Financial Technical Assistance Programs for Local Governments, Skateboard Park Liability Protection, Urban Infill and Community Redevelopment, Post-Preservation 2000 Program, Authority over Police and Fire Pensions, Authority over Municipal Utility Services; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Fort Myers Beach, believes that there will be a variety of legislative proposals that could affect municipal home rule authority and a municipality's ability to respond to the needs and conveniences of their citizenry; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Fort Myers Beach, is a member of the Florida League of Cities, Inc., and fully supports the Florida League of Cities and each position addressed in the 1999 Legislative Action Agenda;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN OF FORT MYERS BEACH THAT:

Section 1. The Florida Legislature respectfully consider the Florida League of Cities' Legislative Action Agenda.


Section 2. A copy of this municipal resolution be sent to Florida League of Cities for its use during the upcoming Legislative Session.


