Beach Access Improvements	
Island-Wide	Dune inspections; sprayed areas with natural fertilizer. Began testing an organic weed preventer
Island wide	Began hurricane prep trimming. All access high trees has been trimmed and cut back
Accesses	All pathway cleared of any overgrown foliage. This will be a month long process
Access signs	Blue identification signs were inventoried and have started the process of being updated with new logo and replace next fiscal year
Aberdeen Access	Car struck the barrier post and tree at the access. Staff re-stabilized the tree and replaced the damaged post

Maintenance Team:

- Shuttled all Town owned vehicles (utility, trucks, vans etc.) requiring maintenance and service to Fleet Services and other facilities as needed
- Trimmed sea grape trees in parking lot and near lift station
- Staff painted crosswalks and slow signage in front of Beach Elementary School
- Staff completed inventory of equipment and supplies within sheds
- Staff completed Public Works requests as received
- Staff prepared for possibility of tropical storm/hurricane and secured items across facilities
- Replace and or repaired multiple signs around the island
- Painted parking stops at Town Hall and under the Matanzas Pass Bridge
- Replaced turtle lights on Estero Boulevard from Lani Kai to Times Square (blue poles)
- Trimmed, weeded, and sprayed areas over the bridge, North and South Towers, Bayview Road, Avenida Pescadora, and Mango Street
- Bring surplus items to storage for future auction
- Picked up a pallet of water and unload it at storage
- Arranged welding project/repair of small utility trailer used for lawnmowers.
- Repaired access gate at the pool for security
- Assembled and installed new hand sanitizer stations for various locations at all Town facilities.
- Arranged onsite repairs for the tractor.
- Coordinated the quarterly generator exercise and tests
- Repaired several Kubotas onsite with salvaged parts from scrapped Kubotas.
- Titled, registered and government plated several Town assets.
- Arranged (PO requests, quotes and transport/return vehicles) tire installation on several vehicles.
- Picked up monthly PPE allotment from Lee County Emergency Services facility.
- Itemized, photographed, loaded and moved to staging area many items for auction.
- Coordinated the Observation Pier cleaning and re-sealant project at the Mound House.

Mooring Field:

*For mooring field revenues, please see Financial Monthly Reports.

- Inventory of vessels within Town's jurisdictional limits; coordination with FWC, FDEP, LCSO for compliance i.e. sea-worthy vessel, lights, pump-outs etc.
- Conducting pump outs weekly (around 600 gallons a week)
- One vessel broke loose due to owner error regarding tie up; no damage was reported
- New pontoon boat acquired for maintenance of systems/field, \$8,000, see pictures below
- Water source repaired at dinghy dock for better access and use for mooring field patrons
- Dinghy dock signage replaced at the dinghy dock under Matanzas Pass Bridge
- Scheduled ZOOM meeting with LCSO, DNR etc. Routine meetings scheduled moving forward
- Meeting with FWC took place we gained access to the FWC database to track Derelict Vessel reports/movement in the Town's jurisdiction.
- One entry sign in the east field was damaged and in need of replacement. Scheduled for repair/replacement
