

ORDINANCE 06-03

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE TOWN OF FORT MYERS BEACH COMMUNITY RESOURCE ADVISORY BOARD ORDINANCE NUMBER 00-07; PROVIDING AUTHORITY; AMENDMENT TO SECTION 3. COMPOSITION AND APPOINTMENT; AMENDMENT TO SECTION 4. QUALIFICATIONS OF MEMBERS; AMENDMENT TO SECTION 6. MEMBERS' TERMS AND VACANCIES; SEVERABILITY; EFFECT OF ORDINANCE AND EFFECTIVE DATE.

IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE TOWN OF FORT MYERS BEACH AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Authority. This Ordinance is enacted pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 95-494, Laws of Florida, Chapter 166, Florida Statutes, and other applicable provisions of law. Additions to the prior Ordinance(s) are indicated by underlining and deletions to prior Ordinance(s) are indicated by ~~strikethroughs~~.

SECTION 2. The provisions of SECTION 3. Composition and appointment, of the Fort Myers Beach Community Resource Advisory Board Ordinance 00-07, as amended by Ordinance 02-03 and Ordinance 05-20, are further amended to read as follows:

SECTION 3. Composition and appointment. The Community Resource Advisory Board (CRAB) shall consist of ~~not less than five (5) or more than seven (7)~~ members appointed by the Town Council.

SECTION 3. The provisions of SECTION 4. Qualifications of members, of the Fort Myers Beach CRAB Ordinance 00-07, are amended to read as follows:

SECTION 4. Qualifications of members. No members of the CRAB shall be salaried officials of the Town. -Membership on the CRAB shall render a person ineligible for membership on any other advisory committee for the Town of Fort Myers Beach during his/her term of office. One spouse per household will be eligible for membership on the CRAB during any given term of office. No current member of Town Council shall be eligible to serve on the CRAB. All members must be residents of or owners of real property located within the territorial boundaries of the Town of Fort Myers Beach at the time of application for membership on the CRAB and during the period of service on the CRAB. All applicants must apply on or before March 1 of the appointment year, with each

application being submitted on a one sheet, 8 1/2" by 11" paper, and include a short biography and short explanation as to why the applicant wishes to serve on the CRAB.

SECTION 4. The provisions of SECTION 6. Member's Term and Vacancies, of Ordinance 00-07, as amended by Ordinance 04-03, are further amended to read as follows:

SECTION 6. The term of office of a member of the CRAB shall be one year or until a successor has been appointed and has qualified, but shall not extend past March 31 of any given year. Appointments shall be made annually at the first meeting of the council in ~~May~~ April. Vacancies in the CRAB shall, within thirty days, be filled by the council for the remainder of the term created by such vacancy.

SECTION 5. Severability. If any one of the provisions of this ordinance should be held contrary to any express provision of law or contrary to the policy of express law, although not expressly prohibited, or against public policy, or shall for any reason whatsoever be held invalid, then such provision shall be null and void and shall be deemed separate from the remaining provisions of this ordinance , and in no way affect the validity of all other provisions of this ordinance.

SECTION 6. Effect of Ordinance. The provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed cumulative and supplemental and shall have no legal effect upon the ordinance establishing the Town of Fort Myers Beach CRAB Ordinance except as expressly provided.

SECTION 7. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.

The foregoing ordinance was enacted by the Town Council upon a motion by Council Member Boback and seconded by Council Member Shenko and, upon being put to a vote, the result was as follows:




