Chapel by the Sea Presbyterian Church U.S.A. 75th Anniversary Celebration.

Whereas, Chapel by the Sea is commemorating its 75th anniversary with a celebration on March 17, 2013; and

Whereas, Chapel by the Sea was founded in the fall of 1932 as a Sunday School class for children; and

Whereas, Chapel by the Sea emerged as a member of the Presbytery in 1933; and

Whereas, Chapel by the Sea's founding minister, Reverend Alexander Linn, secured the required endorsement for building a church on the island; and

Whereas, the first worship service took place on Palm Sunday, April 10, 1939 in the newly completed church; and

Whereas, Chapel by the Sea has provided a vibrant place of worship exhibiting a passion for mission and offering God's holy message for 75 years; and

Whereas, Chapel by the Sea will continue to provide a place to worship God freely in a faith community. It is only fitting to recognize and commend the church on this prestigious milestone.

Now, Therefore, be it proclaimed by the Fort Myers Beach Town Council, in regular session assembled, that we hereby set aside the week of March 17 - 24, 2013 as "Chapel by the Sea Week", to encourage and commemorate the 75th Anniversary of its service to our community.
