

RESOLUTION OF THE LOCAL PLANNING AGENCY OF THE  
TOWN OF FORT MYERS BEACH, FLORIDA  
RESOLUTION NUMBER 2009-23

WHEREAS, the existence of the Local Planning Agency (LPA) is mandated by Florida Statutes Section 163.3174; and

WHEREAS, the Local Planning Agency (LPA) is statutorily responsible under Chapter 163, Florida Statutes, and the Town of Fort Myers Land Development Code (LDC) Section 34-120 for the review of proposed land development regulations, land development codes, or amendments thereto, and for making recommendations to the Town Council with regard thereto and performing such other reviews as are requested by the Town Council; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council requested that the LPA review the provisions of Town Ordinance 07-04 and the prior LPA recommendations regarding parcelization ; and

WHEREAS, at its meeting of September 29, 2009, the LPA reviewed the foregoing documents, considered additional input of staff and the LPA attorney, and recommends as set forth below.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the LPA states there is insufficient additional information or reason to warrant a recommendation of further review by Town Council regarding Ordinance 07-04 at this time.

The foregoing Resolution was adopted by the LPA upon a motion by LPA Member Shamp and seconded by LPA Member Mandel and upon being put to a vote, the result was as follows:


